## **Joseph Manning is Ann's 3<sup>rd</sup> Great Grandfather *Private, 62<sup>nd</sup> Massachusetts, Potter's Unit***

Joseph Henry Manning was born on November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1847 in Boston, Massachusetts. He was the son of Joseph Stacy Manning and Hannah Leach Burns. His father Joseph Stacy Manning was a painter and also served in the Civil War on the Union side.

On Oct 8, 1870 he married Rebecca Haslam (Her former last names have been given as Armstrong, Aslam and McCoy as well) in Manchester, New Hampshire.

They had three children:

1. Maria
2. Delia Hannah who married Joseph Martin
3. William

He enlisted in the Union Army on March 22, 1865 in Boston, MA and was a Private in 62nd Mass. Potter's Unit. The newly formed volunteer unit remained in camp until May of 1865 when they were mustered out.

Joseph Henry Manning died on July 11, 1889 in Derry, New Hampshire. He was 42 years, 9 months and 8 days old when he died. His occupation on the death certificate was listed as shoemaker.

His body was moved from Pine Grove Cemetery (unknown town) to Forest Hill Cemetery in Derry, NH 1906.
